A. Included Components

1. NewsFeed.cs

This is the script that fetches the .txt contents from your server and can then assign them to a UI text component.

2. DemoScene

This is a demonstration scene that contains the NewsCanvas prefab (and thus the NewsFeedScrollView prefab), and has the NewsFeed.cs script running.

This should allow you to check it out in a live situation if you have any trouble understanding how to use it.

3. NewsCanvas


This is a prefab, canvas included, that can be dropped into your scene. All you need to modify is the URL string on the script (attached to NewsFeedScrollView) and point it to your news feed .txt, or patch notes .txt.

4. NewsFeedScrollView

This is a prefab that contains the components and script for the system if you already have a canvas setup. Just drop this into the canvas that you need it to be a part of, position it and change the URL string on the script (attached to the parent object of this prefab) and you are ready to go.

B. Usage

As described above, you have the option of using only the script, only the scrolling window prefab, or a whole canvas prefab. The script itself, or the script attached to the NewsFeedScrollView object (whether as it's prefab or part of the NewsCanvas prefab) has the following options:



1. If not using the prefabs, attach your text component that you wish to fill with news or notes into the “News Feed” slot on the inspector.
2. Enter the URL that points to your hosted .txt file which contains your news or patch notes into the “My News URL” slot in the inspector.
3. Optionally enter a message for if you have an empty .txt file, or there are network problems that cause the .txt to not be fetched into the “No News Text” slot in the inspector.
